The Summer Week has 10 themes with different activities that are designed to develop the children's vocabulary and spoken language skills. The Summer Week also gives children the opportunity to practise the Dutch language in a small group. The WIJS Summer Week is intended for children who have just finished Group 3, 4, 5 or 6 and who have spoken very little Dutch during the holidays because they use a different language at home.

Each theme has creative activities and games. Sometimes the children can also chose reading or writing activities. The emphasis is on spoken language rather than school work.
